

## MASTER OF ARTS IN INTERCULTURAL STUDIES

**Course Aim:** To assist committed missionaries without a basic theological degree seeking academic training in basic theology and mission courses.

### Prerequisites

A. Practical Experience. Those who apply for this degree must have field experience in missions. This might be domestic or foreign, though it need not be long-term service. Applicants for admission must submit documentation of field experience.

B. Call to missions. Those who expect to serve as field missionaries must give testimony of a call to missions in their application materials.

C. Academic Requirements. Applicants for this degree must hold a university or professional degree.

### Academic Format

The courses and seminars comprising this program will be taught in a modular format. The courses are offered in a 2-year cycle.
